

ADDENDUM #3 TO WEST CRISSY FIELD RFP

BUILDINGS, USE AND CONSTRUCTION

1. *May I change the interior volume of a building?*
Most of the buildings along West Crissy Field are historic structures, and therefore most buildings have character-defining spatial relationships that are considered historically significant. Any changes to these character-defining features require compliance with a regulatory process. Irreversible alterations to character-defining spatial relationships are strongly discouraged.
2. *May I add new doors and windows?*
The Trust encourages the installation of doors and windows in locations where such features existed historically. This includes re-using openings that have been sealed or covered.
3. *Are roof penetrations permitted, including skylights and mounted mechanical equipment?*
Any changes must take into account the historic nature of the building and its character-defining features. Roofs are highly visible, character-defining features of the buildings within the Crissy Field complex. Alterations that would adversely affect their character are strongly discouraged.
