

The Programs

We're launching the Center with three flagship programs:

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

A state-of-the-art leadership training center will provide a venue for leaders from all sectors to come together in new ways to respond to today's unique and complex challenges.

RESEARCH

The aggregate knowledge of the service field is a powerful thing. A research center will capture and organize best practices in solving community challenges and provide opportunities to disseminate and share findings via fellowship programs, lectures, and public events.

CONVENING

Beautiful meeting space, accessible lodging, and visitor amenities provide a venue for leaders to convene, plan, and do their best thinking in a setting of meaning and history.

PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

The Plan

The autumn of 2012 marks our first historic renovation, the Headquarters building, as well as the launch of pilot initiatives. A phased development approach will allow the Presidio Trust and partners to test programs while establishing the foundation of a dynamic national center.

GOALS: 2012-2013

Rehabilitate three of the ten historic barracks to house partner offices, classrooms, meeting spaces, and lodging

Create a founding advisory council of multi-sector representation to provide strategic direction and programmatic expertise

Pilot leadership development courses in collaboration with program partners

Develop service-learning programming for local youth and support programs for returning veterans

Establish an organizational structure that ensures diverse participation, program excellence, and financial sustainability


ABOUT THE SITE


