


DOYLE DRIVE REPLACEMENT

The Presidio

The Presidio is a national treasure and a local jewel. It invites visitors to glimpse rare birds and native blossoms; to experience history through carefully preserved buildings and landscapes; and to enjoy a picnic, a concert, or a contemplative walk in the woods. There is truly something for everyone.

The Presidio is located at the Golden Gate, where the Pacific Ocean meets San Francisco Bay. The land was in constant use as a military post for two centuries, first for Spain in 1776, then for a newly independent Mexico in 1822, and finally for the United States from 1846 to 1994. Today, it is both a distinctive national park site within the Golden Gate National Recreation Area and a National Historic Landmark District.

The Main Post, once the heart of military life, is now the vibrant cultural and visitor center of a new Presidio community – the place where many visits begin. Miles of hiking and biking trails traverse the park. The Presidio is also home to extraordinary habitats - coastal bluffs and dunes, a saltwater marsh, a complete watershed, a spring-fed lake, and an extensive forest planted over a century ago by the U.S. Army.

All that the Presidio has to offer awaits exploration via hiking and biking trails, the free **PresidiGo AROUND THE PARK** shuttle, or by guided tours.

TRAILS & OVERLOOKS (see trail map on reverse)

Explore the Presidio on the park's extensive hiking and biking trail network. With 24 miles of trails and eight overlooks and vistas, experiences are available to suit any mood. The Presidio offers both on- and off-road biking opportunities. Trails that are designated as "multiuse" welcome both cyclists and pedestrians. BATTERIES TO BLUFFS TRAIL

LENGTH: 0.7 mile (1.1 km)

TYPE: Pedestrian only; No dogs permitted

DIFFICULTY: Moderate to difficult, with many stairs

BAY AREA RIDGE TRAIL

LENGTH: 2.5 miles (4.0 km)

TYPE: Multiuse; Pedestrian only sections

DIFFICULTY: Easy to moderate

CALIFORNIA COASTAL TRAIL

LENGTH: 2.7 miles (4.4 km)

TYPE: Multiuse

DIFFICULTY: Easy to moderate

ECOLOGY TRAIL

LENGTH: 1.4 miles (2.2 km)

TYPE: Pedestrian on upper trail; Multiuse on lower trail

DIFFICULTY: Moderate to difficult

GOLDEN GATE PROMENADE

LENGTH: 4.3 miles (6.9 km), including loop along Mason Street

TYPE: Multiuse

DIFFICULTY: Easy

JUAN BAUTISTA DE ANZA NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL

LENGTH: 2.7 miles (4.3 km)

TYPE: Multiuse; Pedestrian only sections

DIFFICULTY: Easy to moderate

LOBOS CREEK VALLEY TRAIL

LENGTH: 0.8 mile (1.3 km)

TYPE: Pedestrians only; No dogs permitted

DIFFICULTY: Easy

LOVERS' LANE

LENGTH: 0.6 mile (0.9 km)

TYPE: Pedestrian only

DIFFICULTY: Moderate

MOUNTAIN LAKE TRAIL

LENGTH: 2.6 miles (4.1 km)

TYPE: Multiuse; Pedestrian only sections

DIFFICULTY: Easy to moderate

PARK TRAIL

LENGTH: 1.7 miles (2.6 km)

TYPE: Multiuse; Pedestrian only sections

DIFFICULTY: Easy to moderate

PRESIDIO PROMENADE

LENGTH: 2.1 miles (3.4 km)

TYPE: Multiuse; Pedestrian only sections

DIFFICULTY: Easy to moderate

TENNESSEE HOLLOW TRAIL (FUTURE)

LENGTH: 1.2 miles (1.9 km)

TYPE: Pedestrian only

DIFFICULTY: Easy to moderate

TRANSPORTATION

The PresidiGo Shuttle system welcomes park visitors, residents, and employees...for free! All shuttle vehicles are fully accessible and include bike racks. There are two PresidiGo shuttle services, **AROUND THE PARK** and **DOWNTOWN**.




WEEKDAYS ONLY - The **DOWNTOWN** route makes stops at the Presidio Transit Center on the Main Post, the Letterman District, Union Street / Van Ness Avenue, Embarcadero BART, and the Transbay Terminal.

Visitors may ride the free shuttle (no boarding pass required) from 9:30 am to 4 pm and after 7:30 pm. The shuttle does not run on federal holidays.



TWO ROUTES EVERY DAY - The **AROUND THE PARK** is free and available to everyone all day. The shuttle runs two continuous 30-minute loops (see maps below). Both routes originate at the Presidio Transit Center and connect with MUNI and Golden Gate Transit at several locations. The shuttle runs weekdays from 6:30 am to 7:30 pm. It operates weekends from 11 am to 6:30 pm. It runs a limited weekend schedule on federal holidays.



The **PRESIDIO HILLS ROUTE** is a bi-directional route serving the Letterman District, Main Post, Inspiration Point, Washington Boulevard, Baker Beach, and Public Health Service District.



The **CRISSY FIELD ROUTE** serves the northern Presidio including the Main Post, Golden Gate Bridge, Fort Scott, Crissy Field, and Letterman District.
