The Presidio Trust (Trust) is submitting this closure request for 9 tank sites located at various locations through the Presidio (a total of 11 tanks) and requests that the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) issue “No Further Action” letters for these sites. The Water Board has previously indicated to the Trust that certain fields for Geotracker will be populated for tanks at the Presidio. The Trust is enclosing a live Microsoft Excel file containing information for the Geotracker fields identified by the Water Board for the 9 tank sites. A portable data file (PDF) copy of the Excel file is included as Attachment A of this letter.

The Trust is also transmitting selections of documents relevant to the sites, such as tank pull reports and Mini-CAPs, for Water Board review and uploading to Geotracker. These documents

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may have previously been submitted to the Water Board by the Army or the Trust. These documents are included in a PDF format in Attachment C, with bookmarks for each site. The documents included in the PDF are listed under "Relevant Documents Uploaded to Geotracker" column in Attachment A. The Trust understands that the Water Board will be uploading the information in the Excel file (Geotracker fields) and the PDF documents into Geotracker, as well as assigning a Geotracker number for each site.

For AST 1214.1, please see Attachment B for an additional discussion beyond that provided in the enclosed referenced reports.

For your convenience, soil and groundwater cleanup levels for these tank sites are listed in Tables 1 and 2. As shown in the attached reports, concentrations of chemicals of concern in soil were either not detected or were below applicable cleanup levels.
