Dear Ms. Fanelli:

This letter confirms the completion of site investigation and corrective action at the Phase I Fuel Distribution System (FDS) sections at the Presidio of San Francisco. Site investigation and corrective action results are documented in the *Fuel Distribution System, FDS Closure Certification Report Phase I*, dated January 2006. This report was prepared in accordance with Task 12 of Board Order No. R2-2003-0080. Task 12 requires the submittal of a technical report requesting closure certification for underground storage tanks, aboveground storage tanks, and FDS pipelines.

Based upon the available information, and with the provision that the information provided to Water Board staff is accurate and representative of site conditions, we concur with the recommendation of no further action (NFA) at the Phase I FDS sections. This NFA status applies only to releases of petroleum from the fuel pipelines referenced above. This determination does not apply to groundwater polluted by non-petroleum related chemicals. While the data provided indicate that the site is satisfactory for current land use, we may reconsider this finding should land use change or new information is discovered regarding previously undetected contamination. Water Board staff shall be notified of any changes in future land use.

The existing monitoring wells that will no longer be used should be properly destroyed pursuant to San Francisco County's monitoring well abandonment guidelines. For information regarding these guidelines, please contact the Department of Public Works at (415) 554-5810.
