**RESOLUTION 09-18
TEMPORARY PUBLIC USE LIMITS OF PRESIDIO ROADS**

WHEREAS, the regulation at 36 C.F.R. 1001.5 (Regulation) authorizes the Presidio Trust Board of Directors to impose temporary public use limits and temporarily close all or a portion of the area of the Presidio of San Francisco administered by the Presidio Trust (Area B) to all public use or to a specific use or activity upon a determination that such action is necessary for the maintenance of public health and safety, the protection of environmental or scenic values, the protection of natural or cultural resources, the implementation of management responsibilities, or the avoidance of conflict among visitor use activities; and

WHEREAS, the Regulation requires that the Board of Directors prepare a written determination setting forth the reasons the temporary public use limits or closure is necessary and an explanation of why less restrictive measures will not suffice; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 04-15 the Board of Directors authorized the Executive Director to prepare the requisite determination or finding justifying a public use limit or closure; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director has prepared such written determination (Determination) to impose temporary public use limits of certain roads in Area B for the reasons set forth in the Determination attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors desires temporarily to limit public use of certain roads in Area B and finds that such temporary public use limits do not meet the standard required by the Regulation to be published as a rulemaking;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Presidio Trust Board of Directors adopts the Determination; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors hereby authorizes the Executive Director temporarily to close certain roads within Area B as identified in the Determination and to take all other action necessary to effect temporary public use limits of those roads.
