

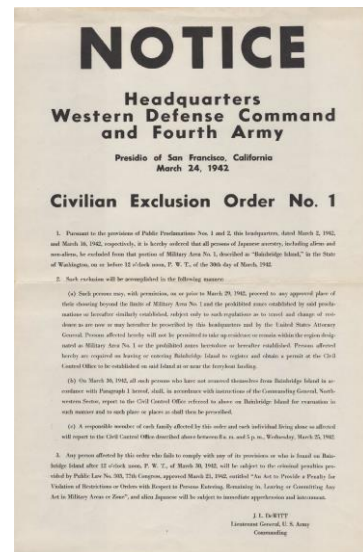

Who created it? What was its purpose?

Who was the intended audience?

Are there any unusual words or phrases?

What is most memorable? What stands out?
